

MINUTES OF MEETING
CITY COUNCIL OF PEACHTREE CITY
August 24, 1991

The City Council of Peachtree City met in a special called session on Saturday morning, August 24, 1991 at 10 AM in the City Hall Council Chambers.

Mayor Brown called the meeting to order and led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance. Those present were: Mayor Frederick Brown, Jr. and Council members Annie McMenamin, Robert Brooks, Rich Parlontieri and Edward Bradford.

Mayor Brown announced that the meeting was called at 9:45 AM on Friday, August 23 and that appropriate notification had been given.

Rich Parlontieri stated that he would abstain from discussing and voting on the issue at hand due to a potential conflict of interest.

Change in License Representative for B & B Bottle Shop, Inc.

Mayor Brown announced that the purpose of the meeting was to consider a change in the License Representative for B & B Bottle Shop, Inc. Mr. William Rhoades, a manager for B & B, was the applicant. Mayor Brown asked Mr. Rhoades if he had read and understood the Peachtree City Alcoholic Beverage Ordinance. Mr. Rhoades stated that he did.

Mr. John Setlock asked if City ordinance required a two week public notice prior to considering a change in the License Representative of a business. Mayor Brown stated that a two week notification was not necessary.

A. McMenamin made a motion that the application of Mr. William Rhoades as the License Representative for B & B Bottle Shop, Inc. be approved.
B. Brooks seconded the motion.

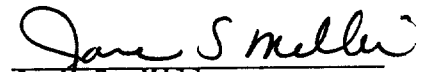
B. Brooks indicated that there were still concerns about some of the activities at B & B and that the City would continue to follow up on these concerns with the State.

Mr. Ray Self asked if it had to be announced and public notice be given that a new licensee was being considered. Mayor Brown explained that a 24 hour notice of the meeting was all that was required and that had been done.

Vote was called and carried with Parlontieri abstaining.
