The City Council of Peachtree City met in a special called meeting on Friday, August 12, 2005, in the City Hall Council Chambers. Mayor Brown called the meeting to order at 7:02 a.m. Other Council Members present were: Stuart Kourajian, Steve Rapson, and Murray Weed. Judi Rutherford was out of town and unable to attend.

The purpose of the meeting was to hold a public hearing to discuss the 2005 millage rate and to adopt the 2005 millage rate.

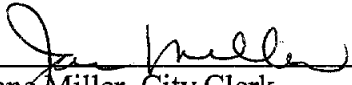
No one spoke either in favor or in opposition.

Brown noted that the proposed millage rate of 5.28 mills included .021 mills to fund expenses for the Development Authority.

Kourajian moved to approve the millage rate of 5.28 mills and to authorize the Mayor to sign the necessary forms. Rapson seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Rapson noted that the millage rate had remained at 5.28 mills even with the approval of the library bond. The cost of the debt service had been absorbed into the budget. The City had to advertise a tax increase due to state law requirements.

There being no further business to discuss, Rapson moved to adjourn the meeting. Weed seconded. The motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:11 a.m.
