6:00 p.m.

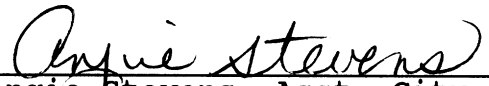
The Mayor and Council of Peachtree City met in joint session with the Recreation Commission on Thursday Night July 21, 1994 at 6:00 p.m. in the Peachtree City Library.

Present were: Mayor Robert Lenox, Councilmembers Annie McMenamin, Caroline Price, Robert Brooks; Recreation Commission Members, Sallie MacGregor, Creighton Warren, Harold Mack, Donald Apking and Jim Costello.

The purpose of the meeting was for discussion of the proposed One Year Local Option Sales Tax Referendum in Fayette County for Recreation purposes, to be held during the November election. Peachtree City would receive a portion of the funds for City recreation needs if the referendum was passed.

After discussion it was the consensus that the Recreation Commission will conduct a public hearing to obtain input from Peachtree City residents on their views. Based on public input, the Recreation Commission will then consider it's position on the referendum.
