The City Council of Peachtree City met in workshop session on Wednesday, June 20, 2007, at 7:35 p.m. Council Members attending were: Mayor Harold Logsdon, Steve Boone, Stuart Kourajian, Cyndi Plunkett, and Judi Rutherford.

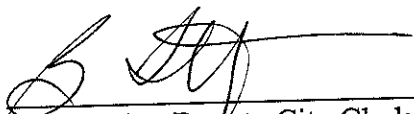
Staff members attending were: City Manager Bernard McMullen, Assistant City Manager/Developmental Services Director Colin Halterman, Public Information Officer/Deputy City Clerk Betsy Tyler, Public Services Director Tom Corbett, Finance Director Paul Salvatore, Assistant Finance Director Janet Camburn, Police Chief Jim Murray, Acting Fire Chief Ed Eiswerth, Leisure Services Director Randy Gaddo, and IT Administrator Matt Robinson.

The purpose of the workshop was to discuss the proposed FY 2007-2008 budget. McMullen noted that this was a follow-up from the June 14 workshop. The items discussed included the starting pay for police/bilingual stipend pay, Fire ISO ratings (how to get from 4 to 3), the building maintenance specialist position, and the assistant city planner (contract) position. Staff also prepared five separate budget options. The variables included staffing, millage rate, and use of cash reserves.

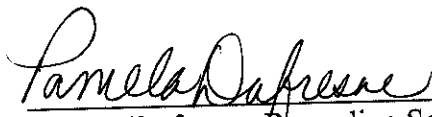
Based on the discussion, the following directions were given by Council – the increase in police starting pay would begin immediately, and the program for bilingual employees should be finalized. The funding for the building maintenance specialist would come from attrition and budget savings in the Public Works department.

The Council consensus regarding the budget options was to work on Option 3 with some modifications.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 9:40 p.m.
