

MINUTES OF MEETING
CITY COUNCIL OF PEACHTREE CITY
Special Called Meeting
June 5, 1990

The City Council of Peachtree City met in a special called session on Tuesday Night, June 5, 1990, at 7 PM in the City Hall Council Chambers.

Mayor Brown called the meeting to order and led those in attendance in the pledge of allegiance.

Council members present were: Mayor Frederick Brown, Jr. and Councilmen David Good, Robert Brooks and Rich. Parlontieri.

Mayor Brown explained that the purpose of the special meeting was to hear comments from the thirteen applicants who had applied for Council Post 2 vacated by Councilwoman Sandi Bongiorno who recently resigned.

The Mayor explained that the applicants would be allowed five minutes to make any comments on their behalf they wished to make and that they would be heard in alphabetical order with one exception. One applicant, Mr. Kiser, had another commitment and he would be heard first. Mayor Brown stated that there would be no questioning of the candidates and asked that there be no indication of support from those in the audience for any of the candidates. The Mayor announced that after hearing from all candidates the Council would go into executive discussion to deliberate on a selection.

Mayor Brown then called upon the candidates to speak.

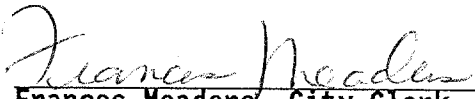

Mayor Brown thanked all the candidates for submitting their resume and appearing to address Council. He felt it would be a difficult decision for he and the Council members to make a selection. He stated that twelve would be disappointed and one would be pleased but he hoped that those not selected would not be discouraged from serving the community at some future date.

Motion was made by Mayor Brown that the Council go into executive session to deliberate on the candidates. Motion was seconded by Good. Motion carried unanimously.
