A special joint meeting of Peachtree City's City Council and Planning Commission was called to order in the City Hall Council Chambers at 6:00 PM on Wednesday, April 13, 1994.

Present were: Mayor Robert Lenox, Councilmembers Annie McMenamin, Edward Bradford and Robert Brooks. Caroline Price was absent. Those Planning Commission members present were Chairman David Piet, Mike Hyde and Julian Campbell. Bill Foley and Joe Alfano were absent. The press was also represented.

The purpose of the meeting was for the City Council and Planning Commission to discuss the policy for possible future annexation of property into Peachtree City.

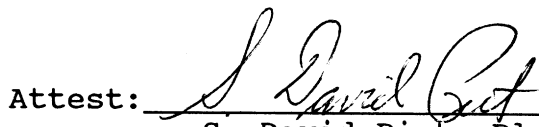
While the current moratorium on annexations remains in effect, both City Council and Planning Commission members agreed that future annexations should be considered, not solely to increase the size of Peachtree City but to enhance the community. There was discussion of providing services, such as Police, Fire and Recreation. All members were in agreement that the Planning Commission and Planning Staff should begin the process of looking into matters concerning possible future annexation and that the Planning Commission would keep City Council advised on a frequent basis.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 6:50 PM.

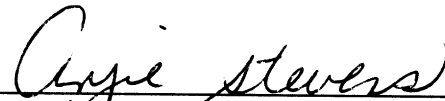

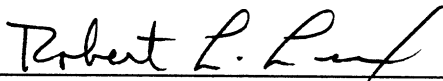
