February 13, 1992

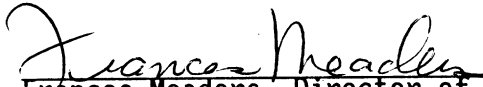
The City Council of Peachtree City met in a special called session on Thursday Night, February 13, 1992, at 6:30 PM in the Fayette County Board of Commissioners Chambers in Fayetteville, Georgia.

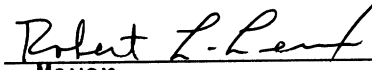
The purpose of the called meeting was to meet and endorse the Water and Waste Water Plan and Map prepared by the Association of Fayette County Governments and to authorize the signing of an endorsement letter to be forwarded to the State Department of Natural Resources. Representatives of the Fayette County Governmental Agencies, the School Board and Georgia Utilities met as a group with the Association of Fayette County Governments so that all could sign the Master Plan letter at the same time.

Mayor Lenox called the meeting to order at 6:35 PM and those present were: Mayor Robert L. Lenox and Councilmen Edward Bradford, Annie McMenamin, and Richard Parlontieri.

Motion was made by Parlontieri that Mayor Lenox be authorized to sign, on behalf of Peachtree City, the Master Water and Waste Water Plan prepared by the Association of Fayette County Governments Committee members and as negotiated by former Mayor Frederick Brown, Jr. Motion was seconded by McMenamin. Motion was carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Bradford that the meeting be adjourned. Motion was seconded by Parlontieri. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting was adjourned at 6:40 PM.
