

City Council of Peachtree City
Minutes of Special Called Meeting
January 20, 2009
7:30 a.m.

The City Council of Peachtree City met Tuesday, January 20, 2009, in the City Hall Council Chambers. Mayor Logsdon called the meeting to order at 7:40 a.m. Other Council Members present: Don Haddix, Cyndi Plunkett, and Doug Sturbaum. Steve Boone was out of town.

The purpose of the special called meeting was to consider the replacement of two thermal imagers for the Fire Department.

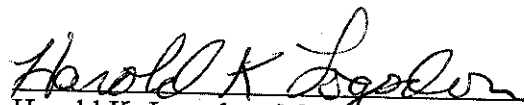
Captain Ron Mundy addressed Council, asking them to approve the bid for two thermal imaging cameras from FirstLine, Inc., for \$16,600 to replace two of the Department's cameras. The estimate to repair the cameras was approximately the same as the replacement cost. Only two vendors were able to provide the equipment. The bid from Fisher Scientific was \$30,734. The reason for expediting the request was due to a price increase of \$1,500 each that was expected on January 23.

Logsdon asked why there was such a difference between the bids. Mundy said the City had always had a good rapport with FireLine, who provided the Department's other thermal imaging cameras. They just provided a better price on the product.

Sturbaum moved to approve the thermal imager replacement. Haddix seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business to discuss, Sturbaum moved to adjourn the meeting. Logsdon seconded. The motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:47 a.m.
