**Call to Order**

Chairwoman Erin McDowell called the Special Called Meeting to order at 8:05 a.m. Michael Polacek, Mike Pappas, Stacey Chapman, and Tommy Johnson were in attendance along with City Manager Justin Strickland, Assistant City Manager Chris Hobby, and Assistant Recreation and Special Events Director Harold Layton.

**Discussion**

**A. Pickleball Site Plan**

The individual members of the group had an opportunity to voice their or other citizens concerns regarding the proposed locations of the pickleball courts. Pappas commented that tennis players do not like pickleball (even though many play) which affect the number of tournaments that come to the tennis center. Chapman said that she had spoken to some players and they are concerned about the mulch center and also the golf cart accessibility. Polacek heard from residents of Planterra who believe that the southside location is more functional. McDowell also spoke to residents of Planterra who were ok with putting the pickleball courts at the tennis center, but a recreation facility located on the southside of the City would turn that area around. Chapman added that the courts could be the first "anchor" for that recreation area. Lastly, Johnson questioned why the group was not looking to put the courts at Glenloch?

With the conversation over, Polacek made a motion that the pickleball courts go to the mulching center. The motion was seconded and the motion carried 4-0-1(Johnson).

With no more business to come in front of the group, Chapman made a motion to adjourn. Polacek seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
