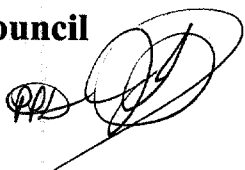

Discussion:

Falcon Hangar B-4, LLC, 500 Aviation Way, Suite B-4, has applied for a Qualifying Location Permit. V. Michael Rossetti, manager, has asked to be considered as the Licensee and License Representative.

Budgetary Impact:

The impact to the budget would be \$150 annually to renew the permit and any fees collected by organizations renting the facility for events. The Special Event Permit fee is \$50; however, the fee is waived for non-profit organizations holding fundraisers.

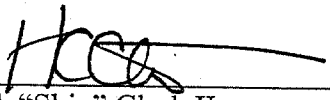

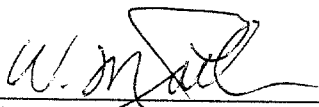

SUBJECT: Qualifying Location Permit – Falcon Hangar B-4
October 25, 2012, City Council Special Called Meeting

Recommendation:

Staff recommends Council consider the attached application for a qualifying location permit and consider waiving the annual fee.

Discussion:

Falcon Hangar B-4, LLC, 500 Aviation Way, Suite B-4, has applied for a Qualifying Location Permit. V. Michael Rossetti, manager, has asked to be considered as the Licensee and License Representative. The application has been made because the hangar will be the site of the American Cancer Society's Cattle Barons Ball on November 10, which is one of the largest fundraisers held in Fayette County. The \$200 application fee has been paid, and staff recommends Council consider waiving the annual fee of \$150.

Budgetary Impact:

The impact to the budget would be \$150 annually if Mr. Rossetti decides to renew to the permit for 2013. The Special Event Permit fee is \$50, which is waived for non-profit organizations holding fundraisers.
