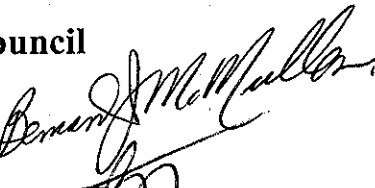

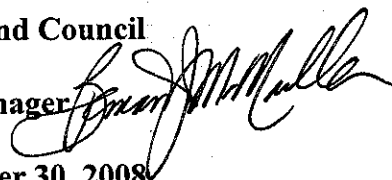

SUBJECT: Consider Waiving Golf Cart Registration for Wyndham One-time Special Event
October 7, 2008, City Council Agenda

Recommendation:

That Council waive the Golf Cart Registration Requirements for Saturday, October 18, 2008, for a one-time special event hosted by the Wyndham Peachtree Conference Center.

Discussion:

The Wyndham Peachtree Conference Center has a client who is requesting a coordinated team building activity using golf carts and the golf cart paths in Peachtree City. Due to the size of the group, their regular vendor is unable to supply adequate registered carts. Representatives from the Wyndham Peachtree Conference Center have requested that Council consider the waiver for this one day event.

Section 78-92 of the Peachtree City Code of Ordinances states that, "Council may, at its discretion, waive registration requirements for special events of a limited duration to which out-of-city residents may bring carts as participants." Council has implemented this waiver on previous July 4th holidays and during the Tour de Georgia.

Budget Impact:

This item should have no budgetary impact.
