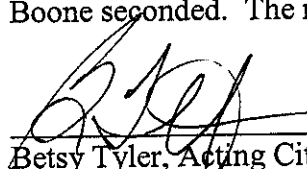
The purpose of the special called meeting was to consider a Memorandum of Understanding for an economic development grant to the Fayette County Development Authority.

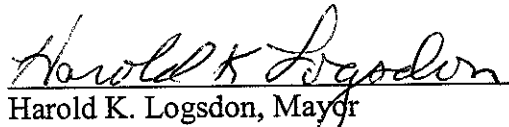

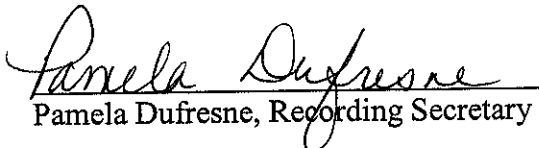
Plunkett asked where the money would be taken from. City Manager Bernard McMullen said that the funds would be taken from FY 2007's Council contingency.
